**Who is this course for?**

The programme will offer those who have an interest in working in the Bio-pharmaceutical industry a knowledge of the fundamentals of the appropriate sciences, the technology and its applications and an understanding of the Good Manufacturing Practice environment.

**Entry Requirements**

Under 23 applicants must have ordinary level Grade 06 or better in five subjects. The subject list must include either English or Irish. Ordinary level Mathematics Grade 06 or better is also a requirement to apply for year one of this course.

Mature students (Over 23 years) are eligible. Eligible candidates may be interviewed. All applicants must have competence on spoken and written English.
