Who is this course for?

This programme will offer those who have an interest in working in the Pharmaceutical Industry knowledge of the fundamentals of the appropriate sciences, the technology and its applications and an understanding of the Good Manufacturing Practice environment.

Entry Requirements

Mature students (Over 23 years) are eligible. Eligible candidates may be interviewed. All applicants must have competence in spoken and written English.
