3years part time with 60 credits per year

#### Who is this course for?

This three-year programme add-on provides a wide range of career and professional development opportunities for persons employed in management positions in industry. The programme seeks to develop their business management skills.

Participants typically come from a cross-section of business, including transport logistics, ICT, healthcare, the food and drinks industries, pharmaceuticals, security, services and construction-related sectors.

#### Entry Requirements

Under 23 applicants must have ordinary level Grade 06 or better in five subjects. The subject list must include either English or Irish.

Ordinary level Mathematics Grade 06 or better is also a requirement to apply for year one of this course.

If a Mature student (over 23 years) you may be exempted from this requirement and are eligible to apply. All applicants must have competence in spoken and written English. *NFQ Level 6 in Management is a requirement for advanced entry into Year 3.*

#### Course Timetable

The course runs 3 evenings a week (6-10pm) over 2 semesters per year

#### Who can apply?

This course is open to all eligible students

#### Course Summary

The course includes a blend of subjects including: international financial reporting; income and corporate taxation; auditing and assurance; financial management and investment analysis along with a personal development module and a blend of information systems modules including an accounting and payroll package and practical application of computer assisted audit techniques. Assessment includes individual and group projects, computer lab assessments, in class assessments and end of semester examinations.

#### Career Opportunities

Students can opt to exit after 2 years receiving a Higher Certification in Business (NFQ Level 6). The student can choose to progress their studies at IT Tallaght at honours degree level in Business Management.
