Who is this course for?

The qualification is aimed at those:

- New to HR or those aspiring to a career in the area;
- Working in HR in support roles who wish to further their career with a professional qualification;
- Line manager, supervisor or team leader roles who wish to develop their knowledge and skills.

Entry Requirements

Applicants must either work currently in a people management situation or have regular access to an organisation to undertake work-based assignments to successfully complete the programme. There are no formal educational requirements; however, it is essential that all candidates have competence in spoken and written English.

Course Timetable

The course runs one evening a week (6-10pm) over 2 semesters, and 2 Saturday workshops from September to May.
