



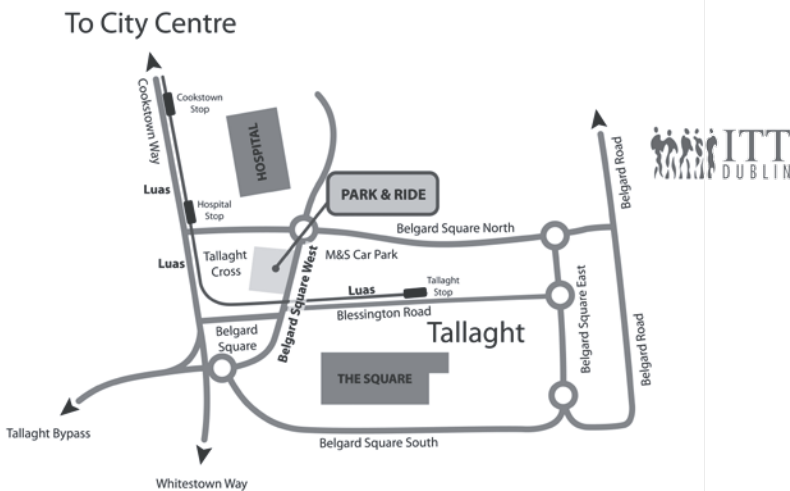
ITT Dublin Transport Guide 2008/09

LUAS SERVICES

The LUAS (Red Line) runs between Connolly in the City Centre and the Square in Tallaght. It stops within a couple of minutes' walk of ITT Dublin.

The total journey time for the red line from Tallaght to Connolly is estimated at 46 minutes.

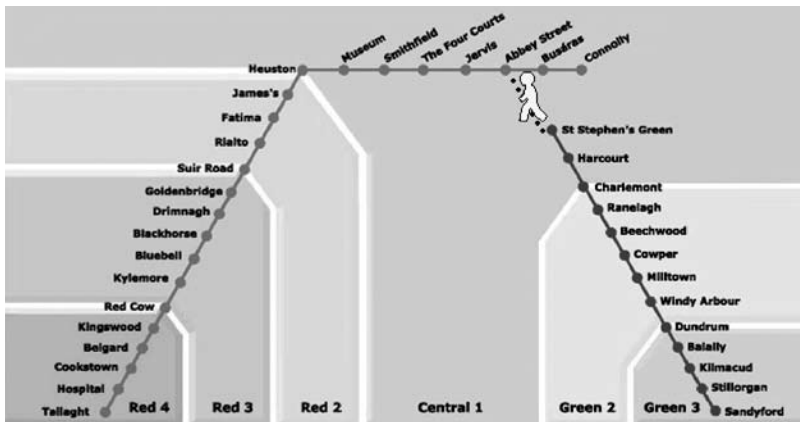

BLACKROCK

Travelling from Blackrock, students can use the DART or Dublin Bus.

Travelling by bus, students should take the 7/a, 17, 45, 114, 115, into the City Centre, then take one of the many buses that travel from the City Centre, directly to ITT Dublin (49/A, 50, 54A, 56a, 65/B, 77/A).

Alternatively, students can take the DART from Blackrock to Dublin Connolly, which takes only 19 minutes, students can then hop on the LUAS, taking them directly to ITT Dublin.

BRAY

Travelling from Bray, students can use the DART or Dublin Bus.

Travelling by bus, students should take the 145, 45/A, 84 into the City Centre, then take one of the many buses that travel from the City Centre, directly to ITT Dublin (49/A, 50, 54A, 56a, 65/B, 77/A)

Or

Take the DART from Bray to Dublin Connolly, and then hop on the LUAS, taking them directly to ITT Dublin.

Or

Students can take the DART from Bray to Dun Laoghaire, then take Dublin Bus No. 75 directly to ITT Dublin.

CELBRIDGE – ITT DUBLIN

Students travelling from Celbridge have a number of options connecting them to ITT Dublin.

Bus Éireann

Bus 120 – Dublin – Edenderry – Tullamore – Birr

Journey time 35 minutes approx.

Palmerstown	Dublin (Connolly)

From Busáras, students should then hop on the LUAS Red Line to Tallaght. Journey time from Celbridge to Dublin Connolly is 30 minutes.

This bus departs every hour until 9.30am, it then departs every 30 minutes until 19.30

Or

Take Dublin Bus No. 67a/b/c to Heuston Station, from there, hop on the LUAS directly to ITT Dublin.

Or

Take the Portlaoise to Dublin train from Celbridge to Dublin Heuston, from Heuston, hop on the LUAS to ITT Dublin.

Total journey time 80 minutes approx.

Or

Private Coach operated by Dualway, travels directly to Tallaght from Newcastle (Alymer Road). This stops at Newcastle, Rathcoole, Saggart, Citywest and Tallaght Square. www.dualway.com

DUN LAOGHAIRE

Students travelling from Dun Laoghaire can take the bus or DART.

Dublin Bus No. 75 travels directly from Dun Laoghaire to ITT Dublin.

Students can also take the DART from Dun Laoghaire to Dublin Connolly, and then hop on the LUAS from Connolly, travelling directly to ITT Dublin.

KILDARE TOWN

The easiest way for students from Kildare to travel to ITT Dublin is:

Take the Bus Éireann bus 126 from Kildare town, to the Red Cow.

Journey time 63 minutes approx.

From there, hop on the LUAS to Tallaght 15 minutes.

Or

Take the Portlaoise to Dublin train to Heuston Station.

Journey time 56 minutes.

From there, hop on the LUAS to ITT Dublin.

LEIXLIP

Travelling from Leixlip, students can:

Take Dublin Bus No. 66 a/b/c to Heuston Station, from there hop on the LUAS to ITT Dublin.

Take the Longford to Dublin train to Connolly Station. From there, hop on the LUAS directly to ITT Dublin.

MAYNOOTH

Take Dublin Bus No. 66/67 to Dublin Heuston, from there, hop on the LUAS to ITT Dublin.

Or

Take the Longford to Dublin train to Dublin Connolly, then take the LUAS to ITT Dublin.

NAAS

Take the Bus Éireann No. 126 from Naas to the Red Cow. From there hop on the LUAS to Tallaght.

Journey time 50 minutes approx.

Or

Take the train from Naas to Dublin Heuston Station from there hop on the LUAS to Tallaght.

Journey time 40 minutes approx.

Students could take the Bus Éireann bus No. 126 to the Red Cow. From there, hop on the LUAS to ITT Dublin.

Take Dublin Bus No. 32 A/B/X, 102, 230 to the City Centre and then hop on the LUAS to Tallaght.

RAHENY

Travelling from Raheny, students can:

Take the DART to Dublin Connolly, and then hop on the LUAS directly to Tallaght.

Or

Take Dublin Bus No. 29 A, 31 A/B, 32 A/B/X, 102, 230 to City Centre and then hop on the LUAS to Tallaght.

FLYBUS

Operating a premium coach service from 4am to 9pm daily Flybus offers passengers a direct, no-nonsense service that gets them from Dublin's south-west region to Dublin Airport direct. Departing from Tallaght (The Square), Clondalkin (The Mill) and Lucan (Liffey Valley Shopping Centre) and travelling direct to Dublin Airport along the M50. Passengers can enjoy the luxury and comfort of air-conditioned, seat belted and the latest low emission engine coaches getting to and from the Airport without the hassle and expense of driving and parking.

Bus Stop Information From Tallaght to the Airport

1. The Square Tallaght: Bus stop at KFC/O'Briens sandwich bar on level 3. (Cinema level)
2. The Square Tallaght: Bus stop outside Super Value beside Tallaght Cross hotel.
3. Belgard Inn on Cookstown Road.
4. Statoil 200 metres past Bewleys hotel Newlands Cross on Fonthill Road.
5. Clondalkin village. Beside Dunne's Stores on 9th Lock Road.
6. Fonthill Road, beside Foxdene estate which is behind the wall at bus stop.
7. Liffey Valley S/C. 10 metres from roundabout opposite motor mall. (Main bus terminus all buses). It is beside VUE cinema (formerly Ster Century) car park.
8. N4 (Galway Road) M50 side of walkover bridge in lay-by. (Opposite side of sliproad into Liffey Valley S/C.
9. Dublin Airport coach park.
