

Fee Payment Dates 2016/17

For students whose academic year commences in September 2016

In order to assist students in paying their student fees, the Institute has the following payment arrangements available to undergraduate programmes for 2016/17.

Tuition Fees

A tuition fee may apply to those who do not qualify for Free Tuition Fees under the Free Fees Initiative (Level 8 programmes) or the Free Tuition Fees Scheme (Level 6 and 7 programmes).
