

## BACHELOR OF BUSINESS IN ACCOUNTING (NFQ LEVEL 7)

1 year part time 60 credits

#### Who is this course for?

This programme aims to provide a level of knowledge and skills in Accounting & Finance that prepares students for middle level responsibility in an accountancy environment. Students who gain the Bachelor Degree Award may exit into the world of employment with this valuable qualification and work in practice or industry in sectors such as financial services, banking, insurance, manufacturing, construction and consultancy.

#### Entry Requirements

A NFQ Level 6 in Accounting or ATI is a requirement for entry to the Add on Bachelor in Accounting and Finance.

#### Course Timetable

The course runs 3 evenings a week (6-10pm) over 2 semesters

This course is open to all eligible students

#### Course Summary

The course includes a blend of subjects including: international financial reporting; income and corporate Taxation; auditing and assurance; financial management and investment analysis along with a personal

development module and a blend of information systems modules including an accounting and payroll package and practical application of computer assisted audit techniques. Assessment includes individual and group projects, computer lab assessments, in class assessments and end of semester examinations.
