The award in IT Management provides deep current skills in web, database, cloud technologies, operating systems, networks and infrastructure. Graduates of this programme have strong technical skills across a range of current IT technologies and are in a position to analyse, configure, make secure and manage the IT resources in an organization.

Career Opportunities

Graduates from this course have gone on to pursue roles as data analysts, cloud architects, support engineers, QA consultants, security engineers, network engineers, database administrators, web developers and IT system managers with such companies as SAP, Microsoft, IBM, Fidelity, Openet, Ergo, Salesforce and Bank of Ireland.
