#### Who is this course for?

This is a one-year part time add-on degree programme for practising chefs (1.5 days week- actual days to be confirmed, but ideally they will be early in the working week)

#### Entry Requirements

Applicants are required to have a Level 7 (ordinary) degree in culinary arts. Applications will be considered from applicants who have gained sufficient industry experience to have achieved the equivalent learning as graduates from an appropriate Level 6 programme. Applicants who wish to apply under the Institute's policy on recognition of prior learning must provide details of their learning.

The Institute will then invite applicants for an interview during which they will be examined as to their suitability for the programme.

All applicants must have competence in spoken and written English that comply with ITT requirements

#### Course Timetable

The course runs 1.5 days a week over 2 semesters

The course is open to all eligible students as per entry requirements

#### Course Summary

This is a Farm-to-Plate Culinary Degree Programme for Contemporary Chefs.
