Entry Requirements

Level 6 in culinary arts/ professional cookery. Applications will be considered from applicants who have gained sufficient industry experience to have achieved the equivalent learning as graduates from an appropriate Level 6 programme. Applicants who wish to apply under the Institute's policy on recognition of prior learning must provide details of their learning.

The Institute will then invite applicants for an interview during which they will be examined as to their suitability for the programme.

All applicants must have competence in spoken and written English that comply with ITT requirements
