Who is this course for?

This course is suitable for students who require a practical and theoretical experience in Masters of Science in Pharmaceutical manufacturing and Process Technology.

Entry Requirements

A level 8 qualification in a relevant science subject with honours is required. Applications without honours will be reviewed based on relevant experience and other qualifications. Bridging reading may be required for students not currently working in the industry.

The course duration is over two semesters. Lecture modules are typically delivered in 3 hour weekly blocks over the semester.
