



Sports, Arts & Culture Scholarship Criteria:

1. Sports, Arts & Culture Scholarships will only be awarded to students when, in the opinion of the Sports Scholarships Committee, they have reached or have the potential to reach a high level of performance.
2. Successful applicants must be registered as full-time students at IT Tallaght for the academic year 2017/2018. Applicants must be an active member of a registered Club or Society for 2017/2018.
3. The value of a Scholarship can be awarded in tiers up to €2000 per annum.
4. It is awarded for a period of one year but may be awarded for up to a maximum of 5 years.
5. Awards will be made in two equal installments in December at the presentation and in March upon review.
6. The recipient of a Sport Scholarship must always make themselves available for training and selection on IT Tallaght Teams.
7. In the event of injury, the recipient must report in the first instance to the staff officer who will in turn refer to the Health Centre. Recipients must follow the recommendations of the Health Centre.
8. The recipients of an Arts or Cultural Bursary must be an active member in his/her respective College Society and aid in the promotion and development of the Society within the College.
9. Recipients will be required to maintain a satisfactory academic standard and an appropriate level of commitment to his/her Club/Society throughout the duration of the Scholarship, and to display at all times an appropriate standard of conduct and professionalism.
10. Recipients must make themselves available for photo sessions and other promotional events, to be determined at the discretion of the Institute.
11. Failure to meet the above requirements may lead to the withdrawal or partial withdrawal of the Award.
